
In compliance with Section 54 of the UK Modern Slavery Act (2015), Sportech is publishing this statement for fiscal year ending December 31, 2018.

As a global entity, Sportech is committed to a zero tolerance policy regarding modern slavery, including but not limited to forced labor, child labor and human trafficking. Sportech has implemented various company wide policies to assist in combatting modern slavery and ensuring fair treatment of its employees including:
